

**KING WILLIAM COUNTY
PUBLIC NOTICE**

The King William County Board of Supervisors will, in accordance with Section 15.2-1800 of the Code of Virginia, hold a Public Hearing on Monday, September 23, 2013 at 7:30 p.m., or as soon thereafter, in the King William County Administration Building Board Meeting Room at 180 Horse Landing Road, King William, VA, to consider the following matter:

The proposed conveyance to the City of Newport News of all properties acquired by King William County between approximately 1996 and 2009 for the now abandoned King William Reservoir Project in execution of project contracts between King William County and Newport News. The properties were acquired by King William with funds provided by Newport News. King William is contractually obligated to convey these properties to Newport News. The properties to be conveyed are described briefly as Tax Map Nos. 38-79, 47-20M, 47-20P, 47-20, 47-20N, 53-81, 47-28A, 45-50D, 46-13, 46-14D, 46-14A1, 46-11B, 38-117B, 46-47, 46-23A1, 46-23B, 46-23C1, 46-10D, 46-10E, 47-27, 46-10A, 38-114C, 38-109C, 38-108D, 46-27A, 47-6F, 47-6G, 47-6D, 47-6E, 47-23C, 47-23D, 47-20E1, 46-26A, 46-15C, 46-12B, 46-4A, 46-4B, 47-23B1, 46-12A1, 46-37B3, 46-37B4, 46-37B5, 46-37B6, 46-37B7, 46-37B8, 46-38E, and 46-14B.

Anyone having an interest in this matter is invited to provide public hearing testimony before the Board of Supervisors. Written testimony also will be accepted prior to the hearing; comments may be submitted by mail to P.O. Comments received by 12:00 noon on the day of the hearing will be distributed to Board members and made a part of the public record.
