



# KING WILLIAM COUNTY ANNUAL DOG LICENSE MAIL-IN REGISTRATION

(Licenses due by February 1<sup>st</sup> of each calendar year)

Article 3.1-796.85 of the Code of Virginia requires owners of dogs four (4) months old or older to obtain a dog license from the county in which the owner resides. Article 3.1-796.93 requires the dog tag to be securely fastened to a substantial collar by the owner and worn by the dog.

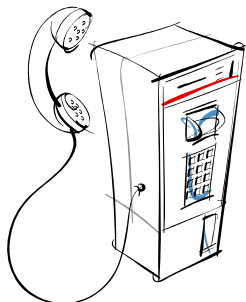
To obtain your dog's license by mail, complete the registration information below and follow the instructions: Send **1.** A copy of your dog's **RABIES VACCINATION CERTIFICATE** (which will be returned to you); **2.** A **CHECK** or **MONEY ORDER** for the applicable license fee, and; **3.** A **SELF ADDRESSED STAMPED ENVELOPE** for the return of the license tag, receipt, and rabies certificate; **4. MAIL TO:** Treasurer King William County, P.O. Box 156, King William, VA 23086.
